



GRADUATE TEACHING ASSISTANTSHIP in Percussion

Interview or Audition requirements:

An initial application including a CV and a performance video that includes solos on Marimba or Vibraphone (4 mallets), Timpani, and snare drum as well as a few standard orchestral excerpts on Xylophone and Glockenspiel, snare drum and timpani. Additionally, candidate may also want to demonstrate knowledge in other areas, Latin percussion, drum set, steel pan etc. The final audition will take place on the WSU campus. It will include a performance recital, an audition with the music director of the Wichita Symphony Orchestra, a short clinic/master class on a percussion topic or instrument of your choice and an interview. Application Deadline:

Graduate Assistantships are available yearly. For priority consideration, all applications materials, including securing admission to the Graduate School, should be submitted by February 15th. Applications are accepted until positions are filled.
